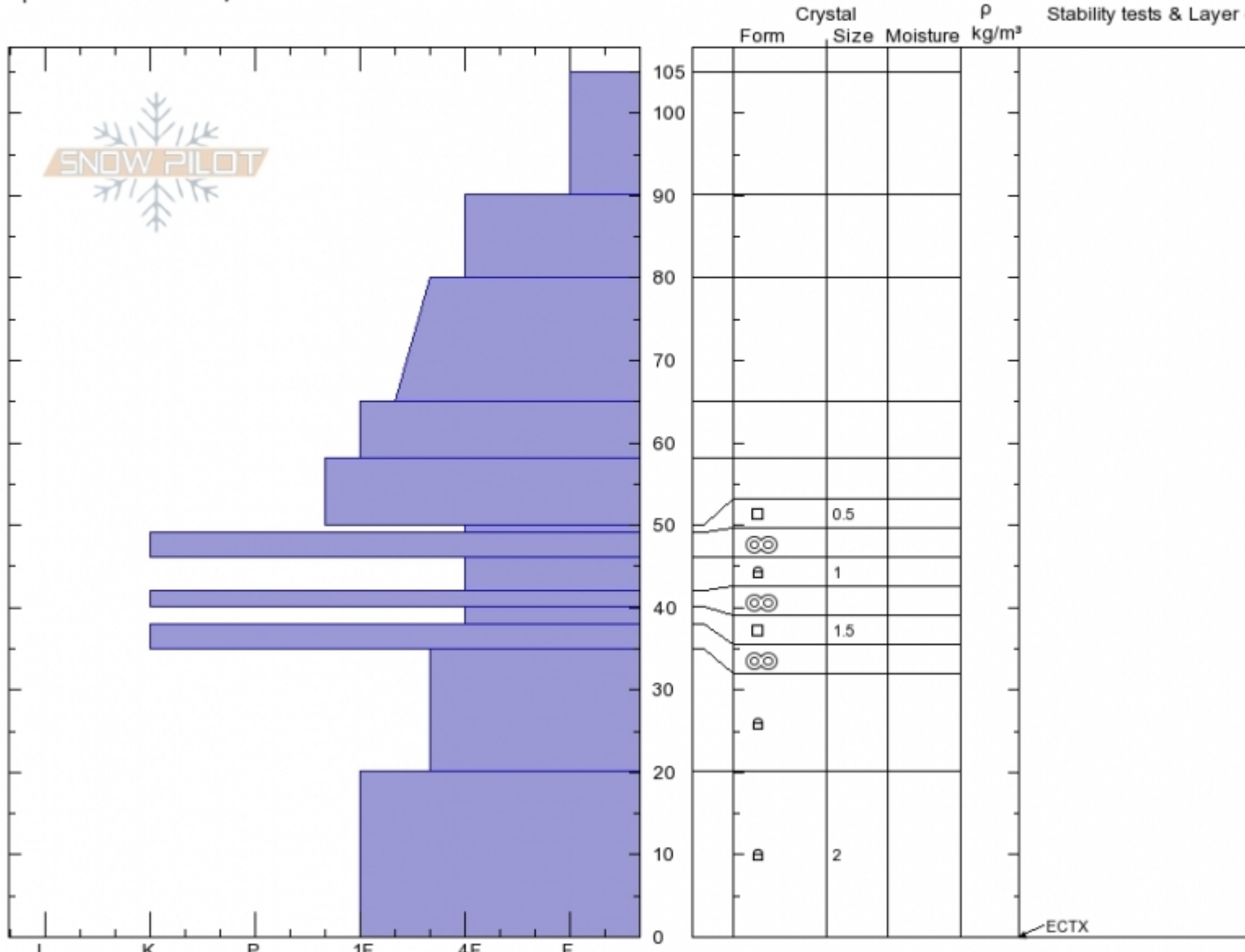

**Notes:** Localized wind effect, and drifts that were pencil hard and were sensitive to the weight of a skier, in areas along the NE ridge (from the 1F to the F winds). These areas did not appear to be widespread. One natural avalanche observed on an upper elevation east/NE aspect near the top of the ridge, left of the Fin. The avalanche appeared to have started from a cornice fall.
