I intentionally triggered some cracking and a D1 soft <u>slab</u> remotely. The <u>slab</u> was about 6"-1.5' deep and about 50' wide. It was a SE <u>aspect</u> around 8700.
Above 9k', the snow structure was looking better, and I was getting ECTNs (<u>snowpit</u> attached), and no more collapsing nor cracking."
